## 3. The date, place of the competition, the office of the competition

The competition will take place on 29-30.06.2019. in Poland in the town of Szczyrk (Śląskie Voivodeship) - Skrzyczne, ul. Myśliwska 45, 43-370 Szczyrk GPS N: 49.707475 E: 19.012711, phone: +48 33 817 86 20

The Competition Office will be located at the bottom lift station to Skrzyczne and it will be open on 29-30.06.2019 in hours 08:00 - 16:00

## 4. Race categories

- Categories Hard Downhill League 2019 - UCI C2:

- ELITE MEN (Born 2002 and older) licensed as Elite, U23 or Junior
- ELITE WOMEN (Born 2002 and earlier) licensed as Elite, U23 or Junior

- Categories Hard Downhill League 2019 – National Calendar

- JUNIOR MEN (license from the 2003-2005 year)
- JUNIOR WOMEN (license from the 2003-2005 year)
- MASTERS I (Born 1980 – 1988), holding the Masters license
- MASTERS II (Born 1979 and earlier), holding the Masters license
- OPEN (Born 2004 and earlier) Unlicensed competitors

In each category, a minimum of 4 competitors must be started. If this number is not reached, the organizer, in agreement with the main judge of the competition, has the right to combine individual categories.

## 5. Conditions of participation

The conditions for admission to competitions are:

- Registration via the application form on the website
- Making a start fee
- Having a well function bike, full-integral helmet, full gloves with fingers, long-sleeved t-shirt, wide thigh padding, neck (and neck) protection, hard shoulder pads, pants (with long legs made of tear-resistant material) knee and shin protection) or large short trousers (made of

tear-resistant material plus rigid knee and shin protector), safety pads (knee pads, elbow pads, spine protector - turtle). In the case of competitors from the ELITE MEN category, according to the UCI regulations, the protectors are strongly recommended.

- For competitors of the Elite Men, Junior Men, Elite Women, Junior Women, Masters I, and Masters II category, possession of current cycling licenses of their national federations and important medical examinations (Juniors and Junior Juniors are obliged to show them)
- Competitors in the licensed categories are required to make a walking inspection of the route within the prescribed time (Can be noted from the start and finish of the route), one training with stopping and one non-stop training the day before the competition.
- On the day of the competition, each of the registered participants must have two training passes before the start of official round (qualification), they will be recorded at the start and finish of the route.
- By completing the application form in the race office, the participant accepts the following clause: “The organizer of the Hard Downhill League 2019 shall not be liable towards the participants of the Hard Downhill League 2019 for personal and property damage that occurs before, during or after Hard Downhill League 2019. Participants take part in competitions at their own risk. Participants bear civil and legal responsibility for all damages. By submitting a signature on the list of participants of the Hard Downhill League 2019 competition, participants waive the right to legal vindication or recourse from the organizer Hard Downhill League 2019 or its contractors in the event of an accident or injury related to Hard Downhill League 2019. By submitting a signature on the list of participants of the Hard Downhill League 2019 competition, I acknowledge that in the event of an accident with my participation (or with the participation of my child or protege) I cannot make any claims against the organizer of the Hard Downhill League 2019 and its collaborators, i.e. sponsors and partners. I am committed to complying with the orders of the emergency services, the judges and the conditions of the Hard Downhill League 2019 regulations. I agree with conditions for participation and report my participation (or participation of my child or protege) in the aforementioned Hard Downhill League 2019 competition. My health state (or the health state of my child or protege) allows participation in sports competitions without the risk of losing health or life. I have read the regulations, formula, and trail of the Hard Downhill League 2019. I am aware of the dangers of participating in the Hard Downhill League 2019. I have valid insurance regarding the consequences of accidents, medical expenses, and sports injuries. I have valid accident insurance regarding the costs of treatment and sports injuries. During the competition, I will not be under the influence of alcohol, psychoactive substances or other substances adversely affecting the ability to assess the situation and the risks arising from participation in the competition. With this signature, I agree to free of charge and unlimited in time and territorially, the use of my image (or the image of my child or protege) by the organizer of the Hard Downhill League 2019 competition and all the persons who cooperate, first and foremost sponsors, photographers, partners and for that reason I will not claim any property rights in the future. Photographs, film recordings and interviews using my image (or the image of my child or protege), as well as the results of competitions with my personal data (or with my child or protege) may be used and published in all fields of exploitation, including, inter alia: press, radio stations, television, advertising banners and billboards (including electronics small and large format), advertising brochures and all other forms of advertising using print or electronic forms of communication (including leaflets, stands - placed e.g. stores, websites.) At the same time, I declare that the use of my image in accordance with the above does not violate anyone's personal goods or rights. With my signature I also assure that I have read all the regulations of the competition rules and completed an application form properly

and truthfully. I hereby consent to my personal data being processed by (company name) for the purpose of considering my application for the participation in sports competitions, as defined in the Article 31 of the Act of August 29, 1997 on the Protection of Personal Data (Journal of Laws of 2014, item 1182, with amendments) (the „Act”).”

As part of the starting fee, each participant receives:

- Medical protection
- Insurance of consequences of accidents
- Race number
- Two-day ticket (29-30.06.2019) for the Szczyrk-Jaworzyna-Skrzyczne lift

The organizer does not return entry fee, to people who did not finish the competition or did not come for the start or did not collect the starting number.

## 7. Entries for competition and collection of the starting number

Entries to the competition must be made at the competition office

Entries for the competition should be made by completing the form in the competition office.

Receipt of the start number is possible only on 29/06/2019. !

The competitor must collect the starting number **IN PERSON** or through his **MANAGER** (upon presentation of the appropriate national federation license) in the Competition Office, only on the day of registration for the competition, on 29/06/2019, until 13:00. The starting number is issued after verification of the identity document, national federation license and correctness of completion and signature of the application for participation in the competition.

***In the case of minors, the presence of parents or legal guardians during the competition is required, as well as the written consent of the parent or legal guardian available in the competition office. The Competition Office employee has the right to identify the parent or legal guardian in order to confirm his or her identity.***

## 8. Limit of participants

The limit of competitors who can participate in the competition is 250 people. The order in which the starting number is picked up at the Race Office counts.

## 9. Race rules

- Riders with UCI license, competing in UCI C2 Race will be classified as Elite aged 17 and over (Elite, U23, Juniors mixed)
- Time is measured in two passes (qualification, final)
- The qualification for the finals is:
  - 75 competitors of the ELITE MEN
  - 40 competitors of the ELITE WOMEN
  - 40 competitors of the JUNIOR MEN
  - 40 competitors of the JUNIOR WOMEN
  - 25 competitors of the MASTERS I
  - 25 competitors of the Masters II
  - 30 competitors of the OPEN
- Riders start in 40 second intervals. In the finals of the last 10 competitors of each category, he starts with an interval of 60 seconds.
- Failure to start at the scheduled time may result in disqualification.
- The competitors start with the numbers provided by the organizer, placed on the steering wheel at the front of the bike and on the left hip
- In matters not covered by these regulations, decide the UCI Commissaire, the Chief Judge in consultation with the Competition Director.
- UCI Class Commissaire scores the UCI classification on the basis of the final results.
- **The fastest rider of the final will be declared winner of race (UCI Regulations 4.3.001)**

## 10. Safety Rules

On the competition trail, marshals are placed in order to signal danger on the route. Marshals are equipped with two flags: yellow and red. A yellow flag is used to signal an accident during official training. A rider, who sees a yellow flag waving, has a duty to stop or slowly descend. The red flag is used to signal an accident during competition. The rider, who sees the red flag waving, is obliged to stop immediately. Detained riders have to go calmly, but immediately and report to the finish line.

- ELITE WOMEN
  - I place – 200 Euro + Medal + Diploma

  - VI place – 72 Euro + Diploma
  - VII place – 64 Euro

## 12. Trainings

The official training is only allowed after the license check, the completion of all registration formalities and the issue of numbers. During training, the player must have a number plate on the bike. Official training will take place according to the following minute program. During the race, training is prohibited.

## 13. The Awards Ceremony

The Awards ceremony will take place about 15 minutes after the end of the competition. The competitors who took the first 6 places in each category are required to decorate. Competitors are required to submit to decorations in racing outfits. The winner of each category is obliged to present his bike during the ceremony, the place for the bike will be designated by the organizer within 6 meters from the podium.

## 14. Program of the event

### Saturday 29.06.2019r. :

- 8:30 – 13:00 – Registration at the competition office, issuing start numbers
- 09:00 – 10:00 – Obligatory pedestrian inspection of the route by competitors (Closed route)
- 10:00 – 15:00 – Mandatory training with detention
- 15:00 – 16:00 – Non-stop training for ELITE licensed riders (OPEN category competitors are not permitted to practice at this time)

### Sunday 30.06.2019 r. :

- 08:00 – Medical security briefing and hanging lists at the competition office
- 09:00 – 10:30 – Training for all categories
- 10:30 – 11:30 – Training only for ELITE licensed riders
- 12:00 – 14:00 – Qualifying
- 14:30 – 16:00 – Finals
- 15 minutes after the final - decorating the winners

## 15. The Penalties

In the scope of penalties, the UCI regulations will apply.

## 16. Composition of the jury

- UCI Commissaire appointed by UCI: Dimitrios Konstantopoulos (Greece)
- National Commissaires is appointed by the PZKOL Judges 'Collegium

## 17. Anti-doping control

During the competition, the anti-doping rules of UCI and PZKOL apply.

## 18. Final provisions

- The competition will be conducted in accordance with the regulations of UCI and PZKOL;
- The use of cameras on the helmet is prohibited during qualifying and final journeys;
- Participants in the competition are obliged to insure themselves;
- The organizer is not responsible for any random events that occurred during the participants' arrival to the competition and return from them;
- Each participant takes part in the competition on his own responsibility (in the case of minors under the responsibility of parents or legal guardians);
- The organizer provides all competitors participating in the competition with the necessary medical care for the duration of the competition;
- The organizer is not responsible for any collisions, accidents on the trail, thefts, damaged equipment, etc .;
- People without starting numbers moving on bicycles along the competition trail will be removed from the route by technical support;
- The organizer does not bear material responsibility for lost items during the competition;
- Lack of knowledge of the regulations will not be considered as an explanation;
- The organizer reserves the right to cancel the event due to the occurrence of natural disasters, unfavorable weather conditions and fortuitous events;
- All competitors are asked not to clutter the downhill route and special care for the natural environment,
- Competitors are required to maintain a personal culture, respect the rules of fair play;
- The Competition Director has the right to refuse to start a competitor without giving a reason or if there is a suspicion that a competitor is under the influence of doping substances, alcohol or intoxicants, or if the Race Director believes that a competitor's start may pose a danger to a competitor or third parties or it may harm the image of the competition or disrupt the course of the competition;
- Registration of participation in the competition is tantamount to acceptance of a given regulation;
- Interpretation of these regulations belongs to the Chief Referee in consultation with the Competition Director.
